



TRAINING COURSE **GUARDING SECURITY SERVICES (GSSB13)**

AWARDS: FETAC/Q.Q.I. (Quality & Qualification Ireland) - Level 4 + S.I.I.

Course Description

This Training Course provides the Candidate with the knowledge, skills and competency to *work effectively and professionally as a Door Security Supervisor and Static Guard within the Guarding Services Sector of the Irish Security Industry, performing practical Security duties and procedures as well as responding to Security situations in a wide variety of settings. (*Work- PLEASE NOTE: You must have a PSA (Private Security Authority) Licence to work in Security Sector – for details see website: www.psa.gov.ie). Upon successful completion of Training Programme you can apply for the PSA Licence.

Course Duration

The course duration is a minimum of 120 hours: 40 hours direct contact classroom time and 80 hours self-directed learning. Candidates must conduct a home study element of the course during the training program and research which covers the more theoretical aspects of the program. The more practical aspects and skills are developed during direct contact.

Course Cost

The course fee is €450 per person, includes: Delivery of Training over five days (120hrs); Course Notes; Hand-Outs; Examination Preparation, Assessment, and Submission; Theoretical, Legal & Physical Aspects including Response to Threat & Violence; and Certification from Security Institute of Ireland, and QQI (FETAC).

Requirements for entry to programme and ultimately the industry

1. Working knowledge of the written and spoken English language (English need not be first language.)
2. Reasonable level of fitness and mobility.
3. Must be over 18 years of age.

Participants are required to bring for registration purposes

1. A colour photocopy of their passport or driver's licence.
2. Two passport sized photos.
3. PPS number.
